



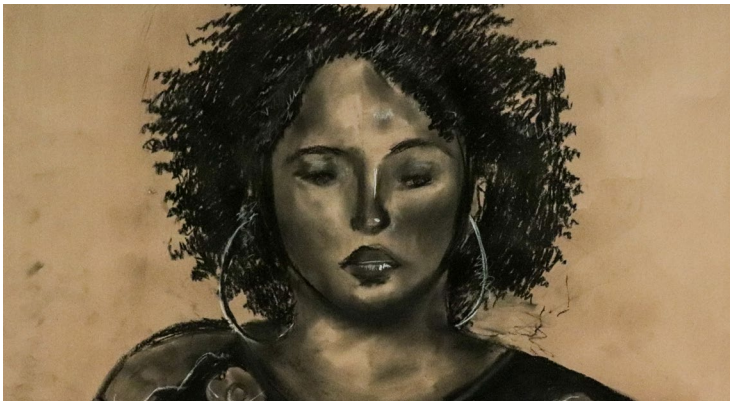
Tyler Art Start is a unique full scholarship pre-college program for talented Philadelphia high school students entering 11th and 12th grades. Creatively driven students are nominated by their teachers and guidance counselors for admission into the program. Following the success of our Online Summer 2020 Pre-College Programs, and given the continued risks associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, we have made the decision to remain 100% online for fall 2020. Art Start has been adapted specifically for online learning to be as interactive as possible and will include a mix of:

- **Live face-to-face instruction and presentations with your instructors**
- **Time for hands-on art making and projects, both independently and in small groups**
- **Critique and discussion of projects with your instructors and classmates**
- **Virtual studio visits and guest lectures by practicing professionals**
- **Online resources such as virtual museum tours, site visits and demonstration videos**

PROGRAM

Art Start is intended to broaden students' horizons by allowing them to explore new media and interests, develop technical skills, discover creative career paths, and experience college-level classes. The program includes classes in both 2D and Digital Art. Participants learn how to use a variety of drawing mediums, as they expand their grasp of the importance of drawing from direct observation. They also investigate the creative applications of digital and interactive media programs, such as Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop and After Effects, through projects that introduce graphic design, digital photography, and video art. Classes are taught by dedicated faculty and provide students with an immersive studio art experience. All supplies are provided.
